ImPulsTanz: Application start for the education and training programmes 2023

After a highly successful festival summer 2022, ImPulsTanz is pleased to network and invite the international dance world to Vienna once again in 2023. In addition to ATLAS – create your dance trails and danceWEB, the continuing education programme ImPacT, which is dedicated to the intensive exchange of students and experienced dance professionals, is offered. In addition, the DanceAbility Teacher course is held for the ninth time already, aimed at those teaching integrative groups in the field of movement arts.

ATLAS – create your dance trails is a five-week training programme that offers young artists with first choreographic experience and mid-career artists a dynamic environment for their personal and artistic development. It addresses two central needs: on the one hand, to have a studio available for research and piece development, and on the other, to gain new input through individual workshop programmes, visits of international productions and exchange with artists from over 100 countries as well as through peer-to-peer exchange within the group. The programme is accompanied by performer and dramaturg **Angélique Willkie**, who worked with Alain Platel and Sidi Larbi Cherkaoui, amongst others, and currently holds the professorship of contemporary dance at Concordia University in Montreal, Canada.
